Steps on How the 120-hour Program Works

- Visit the website of the NC Division of Health Service Regulation (DHSR) for details on the certification requirements: https://www2.ncdhhs.gov/dhsr/acls/adminguidelines.html
- Register for the NCSLA AIT two-day course (16 hours) of classroom instruction, taught by assisted living professionals who provide an overview of laws, rules, policies and procedures.
- In the NCSLA AIT course, you will receive instruction and course materials on rules and regulations, personnel, regulatory management, PCS services, resident care management, nutrition and food service, and environmental and housekeeping.
- Course payment is due in full in advance of the course date (received one week prior) and is **non-refundable**.

• A minimum of 100 hours will be spent working with an approved Preceptor at a licensed facility. There is a self-study portion with work assignments to be completed. Additional hours can be required if determined by the AIT provider and Preceptor. It is highly encouraged that the AIT identify a Preceptor of choice prior to attending the classroom training.

It is recommended that the AIT program be completed within 6 months of course completion.

- Administrator Rules Exam
